In general these packages include consultation, initial hospitalisation, imaging (either radiographs or CT depending on the procedure) under sedation, anaesthesia, surgery and implants. They do not include medications, blood tests, post operative rechecks and additional procedures. The prices stated are a guide and are not guaranteed due to the individual nature of each case.



TPLO <20Kg (and extra-capsular stabilisation)	£4,500
TPLO 20-40Kg	£5,500
TPLO >40kg (additional costs may be payable for large and giant breeds should specific/additional implants be required)	£6,000

Patella Surgery

Patella <20kg unilateral	£4,000
Patella >20kg unilateral	£5,000
Patella <20Kg bilateral	£5,000
Patella >20kg bilateral	£6,000

Arthroscopy

Joint arthroscopy – unilateral (e.g. elbow or stifle)	£4,500
Joint arthroscopy – bilateral (e.g. elbow or stifle)	£5,000

Simple fracture include radiographs

Simple fracture level 1 (e.g. tibial tuberosity avulsion)	£4,000
Simple fracture level 2 (e.g. simple distal radius and ulna fracture)	£5,500
Simple fracture level 3 (e.g. fracture of the lateral condyle)	£6,500



Complex fractures include non-contrast CT

Complex fracture level 1 (e.g. comminuted femoral diaphyseal fracture)	£6,000
Complex fracture level 2 (e.g. comminuted acetabular fracture)	£7,500
Complex fracture level 3 (e.g. 'Y' elbow fracture)	£8,500
FHNE (not neoplastic or complex)	£4,000
Stem cell injection	£2,000
