- Initial consultation with full ophthalmic examination
- Conscious diamond burr debridement under local anaesthetic
- Contact lens placement
- Re-examination after 10-14 days

Cataract Surgery

This package includes:

- An initial consultation with a member of our specialist-led Ophthalmology team

The following preoperative investigations (if applicable):

- Electroretinography
- Ocular ultrasound – performed by our specialist-led Diagnostic Imaging team
- The cataract surgery itself (including placement of an artificial lens)
- General anaesthesia (including neuromuscular blockade performed by our specialist-led Anaesthesia team)
- Twice daily postoperative examinations and 24-hour intraocular pressure monitoring during hospitalisation
- 24-hour nursing care (with support provided by our 24-hour onsite vets)
- Hospitalisation for up to three nights (as required)
- First re-examination appointment
